Visiting the Butterfly House and Insectarium










At the Museum of Life and Science, there is a Butterfly House and Insectarium.




In the Butterfly House, it is hot and humid. The butterflies need hot, wet air to live.




Butterflies may fly around me.

When I leave, I can look in the mirror to make sure there are no butterflies on me.








In the Insectarium, there are many different bugs and insects.
